The Government of Barbados (GOB) through the Ministry of Tourism and International Transport (MTI) is inviting tenders from firms/consultants to provide consultancy services to conduct Visitor Exit Surveys for Barbados for the period January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2021. The surveys are to capture information on long-stay visitors and cruise passengers to Barbados on a quarterly and annual basis, that includes visitor profiles, travel planning and behaviour, visitor opinions and perceptions, details of expenditure levels and patterns and other demographic and financial characteristics.

Prospective tenderers must provide information establishing that they are qualified to perform the services by submitting evidence of their past experience in undertaking similar projects and the availability of appropriate skills. Firms/consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. All corporate tenderers must include with their application a copy of the company's Certificate of Incorporation as evidence of the fact that the company is an existing registered company as at the date of application. The certificate must be in the name of the tenderer. Local tenderers are advised that the Certificate of Incorporation referred to at the paragraph above means a Certificate of Incorporation issued under the 1985 Companies Act of Barbados, or where applicable, a Certificate of Continuance and/or a Certificate of Amendment. Certificates must be dated after December 31, 1984.

Any company incorporated outside of Barbados which is awarded a contract will be required to be registered in Barbados as an External Company under the Companies Act of Barbados.

APPLICANTS SHOULD BE AWARE THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THE LABOUR CLAUSES (PUBLIC CONTRACTS) ACT CAP. 349 SHALL, IN SO FAR AS THEY ARE APPLICABLE TO THE TENDER, APPLY TO ANY CONTRACT MADE IN RESPECT OF THE TENDER. FULL DETAILS OF THE CONDITIONS OF THE ACT, CAP. 349 MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE GOVERNMENT PRINTER, GOVERNMENT PRINTING DEPARTMENT, BAY STREET, ST. MICHAEL, CONSULTANTS SHOULD SUBMIT THE CERTIFICATE REQUIRED BY THIS ACT WITH THEIR TENDER.

The successful bidder(s) will be required to enter into a Contract drawn up by or in a form approved by the Solicitor General or another Legal Officer in the Public Service approved by her. A surety for the due performance of the contract will be required by way of one of the following methods listed below:-

- a. By way of a deposit with the Treasury of a sum of money or approved sureties to the value or not less than 10 per cent of the price; or
- b. By way of a Bank or an accredited Insurance Company whose liability shall not be less than ten per cent of the contract price.

The cost of obtaining such a surety shall be the responsibility of the bidder who need not specifically make arrangements for sureties unless and until his bid has been accepted.

12. CRITERIA TO BE USED FOR AWARD OF THE CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS.

A two-stage procedure shall be used in evaluation based on the Quality Cost Based Method of Selection. First, the Technical Proposals will be evaluated then the Price Proposals of those submissions achieving a minimum score of 70 points for their Technical Proposals will be evaluated.

Technical Proposals will be awarded points based on the following factors:

- Methodology and Work Plan 0-25 points
- Organisation, Qualifications & Staffing 0-20 points
- Experience in similar projects 0-40 points
- General experience in the region 0-15 points
